



The highly acclaimed Dish restaurant is located in The River Inn in the Foggy Bottom neighborhood of Washington, DC. The restaurant has received excellent reviews for its American fare and light-filled, sophisticated design. Windows in the cozy dining room overlook the neighborhood's tree-lined residential streets, and the Kennedy Center is a short walk away.

A highlight of the contemporary space is a large photographic diptych by William Wegman. The restaurant, which offers seating at just 13 tables, consistently attracts both a loyal local following as well as a steady pre-theater crowd.
